RULES & REGULATIONS

- 1 Art Expo 2012 is open to all students currently enrolled in any ASU course for credit.
- 2 All media is eligible. Each student may submit up to six artworks.
- 3 Students are responsible for entering work in the category most appropriate for each piece. Categories are: **On/Of/In the Body, Social & Political Concerns, The Natural World, Functionality, Time, Narrative, Process & Materials, Formal Matters, The Written Word.**
- 4 All works entered must have been created within the past three years and not previously shown in the Catherine J. Smith Gallery. All works must be properly registered, labeled, displayed, and picked up according to the rules and dates listed in this prospectus.
- 5 Seniors in the following programs must submit four to six recent works to fulfill graduation requirements: BFA Studio, BA Studio Art, BS Art Management, BFA Graphic Design and BS Art Education. [*BFA Graphic Design- four submissions must be recent graphic design work]
- 6 Seniors must complete the appropriate form at registration for graduation credit.
- 7 All works selected for the Art Expo 2012 exhibition must be properly labeled and ready to hang or display according to Catherine J. Smith Gallery policies listed in Gallery Usage. All works must be dropped off and picked up on the correct days and times listed in Important Dates.

GALLERY USAGE

The Catherine J. Smith Gallery attempts to accommodate and support all exhibiting artists by providing installation assistance, advice, and support materials (such as pedestals and vitrines) for objects on display. In order to provide assistance in a timely and professional manner we request the following:

- 1 Label all works with your name, exhibitor #, category, title of piece, medium, date, price, and size (HxWxD). Attach this label to the lower right corner of the front of the artwork. All information on the labels must correspond to the information submitted on the registration form.
- 2 If the work is 2D, it must be ready to hang and framed, if appropriate.
- 3 If the work is 3D, please indicate its size (HxWxD) and whether it will require a pedestal or covered vitrine when delivering work to the CJS Gallery.
- 4 A CJS Loan Agreement must be filled out and signed at the time of delivery.
- 5 All exhibiting artists must abide by the deadlines listed in Important Dates.

Participation in this exhibition and your signature on the registration form indicate an understanding of the gallery usage policies and rules & regulations pertaining to this exhibition.
