- Completed scholarship application for Art Majors ONLY if applying for other scholarships and awards in addition to the Humphrey

### **Marianne Stevens Suggs Travel Award for Fibers**

- Rising junior or senior with a declared major in Art, with a strong grounding in Fibers
- Minimum Grade Point Average of 3.0
- Must be enrolled in at least one Fibers course in the year the award is received
- Funding is for student travel opportunities
- Completed Stevens Suggs Fibers Student Travel application
- Completed scholarship application for Art Majors ONLY if applying for other scholarships and awards in addition to the Suggs

### **Art Mart Award**

- Annual award in form of gift certificate, preference given to Entering Freshmen and Sophomores
- Minimum Grade Point Average of 3.0
- Completed scholarship application for Entering Freshmen OR
- Completed scholarship application for Art Majors

### **The Cheap Joe's Award for Senior Studio**

- Two awards, one for spring and one for fall
- Student must be enrolled in senior capstone course for semester in which award is received
- Minimum Grade Point Average of 3.0
- Completed scholarship application for Art Majors
